Q1 (a) Accidents should be prevented as they involve high direct costs and indirect costs to an organization.

Explain the SIX (6) principles of accidents prevention.

(b) Ahmad is working on a ladder and the ladder seems to collapse. Ahmad falls down the ladder and breaks arm. From the investigation of the accident, it shows that:

Ahmad had worked seven 12-hour shifts in a row. It happened at the end of shift. Ahmad was standing on the top step of the ladder and he was approximately 10 feet above floor level. During the incident, no fall arrest or restraint system was used. A ladder inspection policy is in place, but there was no evidence that the ladder has ever been inspected. Investigation reveals the ladder was damaged and did not provide a stable working platform in any environment. An interview with facility manager, Badrul, revealed that he did not inspect the ladder when it was due for inspection although He was aware that the ladder needed to be inspected.

- (i) Explain the type of accident regarding the above scenario. (4 marks)
- (ii) Analyse **FOUR (4)** root causes of accident of the above scenario. (8 marks)
