



2013 CIE-TVET Can Churn Out Creative, Innovative Researchers

KUALA TERENGGANU, Sept 2 (Bernama) -- The 2013 Conference in Education - Technical and Vocational Education and Training (2013 CIE-TVET) can churn out researchers who can create innovative products for the global market.

Universiti Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia (UTHM) Vice-Chancellor Professor Datuk Dr Mohd Noh Dalimin said 2013 CIE-TVET was to enrich research and innovation among lecturers and students, raise professionalism of educators and boost the quality of graduates.

"The conference can also strengthen the knowledge of participants on research on a continuous basis to enable them to create products which can be commercialised at the global level," he said.

He said this at a media conference, in conjunction with the opening of the two-day conference here on Monday.

A total of 130 working papers will be tabled at the conference, with the participation of 183 people and presenters from public institutions of higher learning and an international delegation from the Regional Cooperation Platform, Tongji University, China.

The conference is jointly organised by UTHM, Polytechnic Studies Department, Community College Studies Department and Higher Education Leadership Academy, with the cooperation of four other organisations.

Organised for the third time, the conference is themed, 'Strengthening Research and Innovation towards transforming Research and Innovation'.
