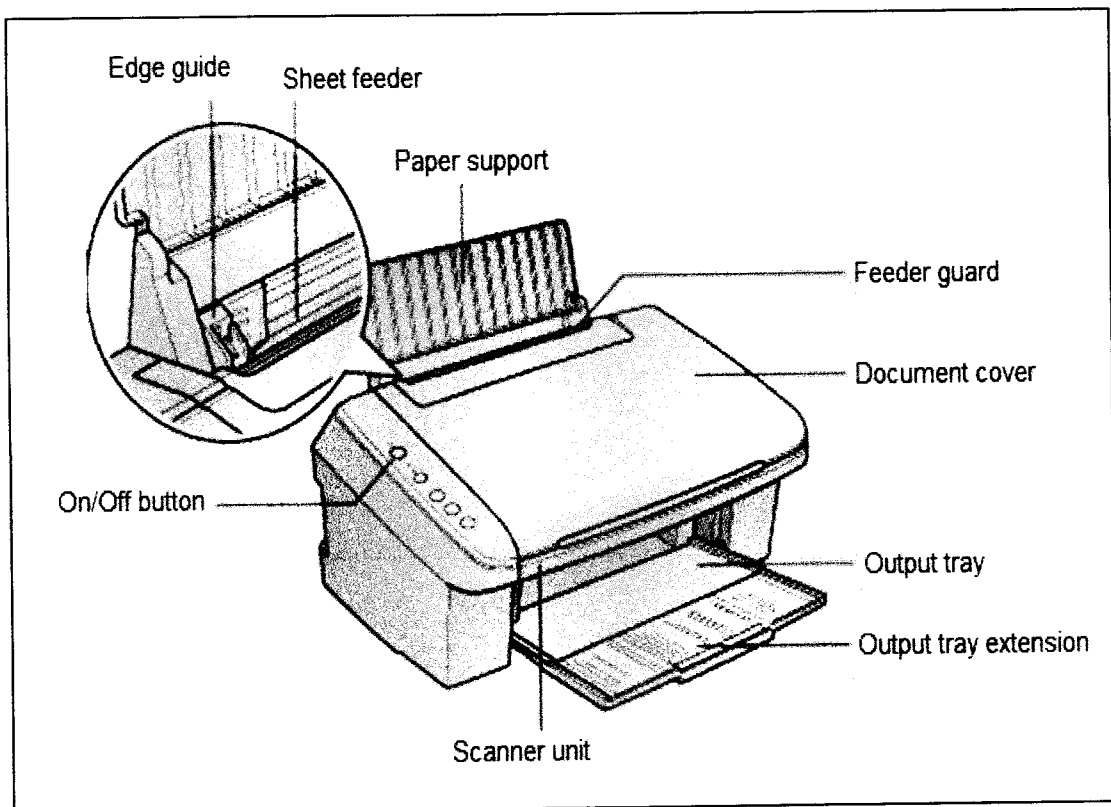


Figure 1: Printer
